# MAY & JUNE EVENT RECAP

Our CPYF team has been BUSY in the community this spring, working with members of the Calgary Police Service to deliver engaging, informative, and fun events to children and youth in various communities throughout Calgary. Below are some of the highlights from these impactful community initiatives.

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#### **Bike Safety Days**

Over the past two months, CPYF has partnered with CPS District 1, 2, 7, & 8 to host Bike Safety Days (top right) for over 1,800 children and youth. At each of these events, the children and youth were taught about bike safety including the proper equipment to wear, the rules of the road, and how to ride safely in their community. They were also provided giveaway items, whether it was a new bike, helmet, lock, or bell to help keep them safe. These events provided children and youth the opportunity to interact with police officers in a positive way, while learning about the importance of bike safety.

#### YMCA Youth Hoops Basketball Tournament

CPYF partnered with CPS, YMCA Calgary and other community organizations to help host the YMCA Youth Hoops Basketball Tournament for Indigenous youth. This three-on-three tournament featured live music, contests, cultural performances and more. The participants had a great time playing against each other, interacting with CPS officers, and checking out their cool swag bags!

#### **District 8 Basketball Games**

CPS officers from District 8 also partnered with CPYF to host a basketball tournament of their own, inviting Grade 9 students from two schools to play a game against CPS officers (*middle right*). Children and youth had the opportunity to interact with the CPS members in a fun environment while playing their favourite sport, and they also received a swag bag of goodies to take home.


